Cyclone "Gaja" has wreaked havoc in ten districts of Tamil Nadu, when it struck the coast of Nagapattinam at midnight on November 15, 2018. It has devastated the coastal areas of Nagapattinam district, shattering homes and destroying villages. About 3.8 lakh people are in temporary camps in these districts. Not a single tree could be seen standing, not to mention crops, fishing boats, and homes in several villages. Thatched roofs have been blown away making people homeless and the children have lost their school bags, books and notebooks. It could be a month before power is restored as more than 30,000 electric posts and every transformer is severely damaged.

About Vanavil Trust

Vanavil Trust runs a primary school and a training center.

Vanavil Primary School is an alternative school working closely with two of the most marginalized communities in Tamil Nadu. Boom Boom Mattukarars and Narikuravars are ancient nomadic tribes who have been forced to eke out a living through begging and selling minor wares. Vaasal Training Center started in 2018 addresses the critical gap between education and employability for the youth of Nagapattinam. As one of the most backward districts in India, youth of Nagapattinam do not have many opportunities and most often they are not even aware of what is available to them. Vaasal aims to address that through training for higher education entrance exams, TNPSC coaching, computer literacy and counselling for available opportunities.

Who are we helping?

Vanavil's efforts will focus on reaching out to affected families in and Vedaranyam, Keezayur and Thalaignayiru blocks of Nagapattinam district.

Vanavil team has visited these villages and assessed that approximately 5,000 families are in immediate need of relief supplies.

Relief efforts will be led by Ms. Revathi Radhakrishnan, Managing Trustee, Vanavil Trust and Mr. K. Natarajan, Coordinator, Vanavil Trust. They will be supported by a team of Vanavil volunteers and local leaders.



The Vanavil Advantage

Vanavil is uniquely positioned to spring into action quickly and provide relief. In fact, the genesis of Vanavil dates back to another natural calamity, the Asian Tsunami of 2004. A group of young volunteers decided to start Vanavil to help the extremely marginalized communities they came across while doing Tsunami relief work.

In addition to the previous relief work experience, having been operating in that area over the last 13 years, we are intimately familiar with all the villages around the town of Nagapattinam. Moreover, the relationships we have built with a lot of local leaders will help us immensely to do efficient relief work at this time of dire need.

What is in the relief kit?

Each relief kit will contain the following.

We are using the Vanavil school bus to carry relief materials and they will be personally handed over to families in need by our volunteers.
